Joining hand-in-hand with families, we can realize California's promise of a healthy, hopeful, and equitable future for birthing people, babies, toddlers, and young children.

We envision a society rooted in racial and economic justice where all children are embraced, valued, and cared for, and where every child has access to systems and services promoting their health, well-being, and the life opportunities that enable them to thrive.



California boasts the fifth largest economy in the world, yet too many families of babies and young children are denied essential resources and support, stunting their chance for an opportunityrich childhood. This challenge is particularly prevalent in our Black, AAPI, Latine, Indigenous, and immigrant communities.

Our children's futures hinge on the health and well-being of their support network. Parents, educators, doulas, and entire communities form this crucial foundation. However, communities of color are disgracefully shortchanged by government systems and public services

Consequently, Black and Indigenous birthing individuals confront alarmingly higher risks of complications or death during childbirth, countless babies miss out on the vital care needed for healthy development, and young children are denied the early learning experiences they need. This must change. Let's rally for equitable transformation—every family, every community, deserves their rightful access to opportunity and care.

What we are doing:

Together with families and communities, we fight for policies that support children's early learning and care, families' access to health care, mental health services, and economic mobility. By centering centering family and community voices, we advocate for a California where every family has:

- **System Navigation:** Strong community support systems, with culturally affirming services that provide guidance, education, resources, and a sense of belonging.
- **Economic Opportunity:** Access to living wages, paid family leave, and financial support that alleviate the stress of poverty and allow parents to focus on their children's well-being.
- **Pregnancy and Postpartum Support:** Breastfeeding and body feeding support, developmental screenings, and postpartum and mental health services.
- **Early Learning and Child Care:** High-quality, culturally, and linguistically affirming early learning experiences that nurture children's development and prepare them for success in school and life.
- **Health Coverage and Care:** Affordable, reliable, and high-quality health coverage and care.
